049/21 Minutes of Meeting

053/21 Essex Highways Devolution Scheme

a) Cycle paths within the Parish

Information regarding dual use of paths to be investigated. It was **resolved** that this plan would be added to the ongoing projects list.

b) Update and action required on reportable issues list

It was **resolved** that the non-reinstatement of the block paving in Church Road, following work carried out by Anglian Water, would be added to the reportable issues list in order to progress the matter.

c) Update and action required on projects list

An updated Factory Corner proposal would be sent to Cllr Mannion in time for the 7th December Local Highway Panel meeting along with the request for a further traffic survey to be undertaken in respect of a crossing in the vicinity of Asda plus progression of the footway along Maldon Road (opposite Ship Inn) scheme.
